NPG Gelcoat – the most water resistant gelcoat available, and backed with vinylester/epoxy resin under waterline, and isophtalic polyesters elsewhere Foam Core sandwich construction throughout, with double bias or bi-axial glass fabrics. Carbon fiber is used selectively in highly stressed areas, while main hull keel is reinforced with Kevlar, both sides of core. This helps stiffen the hull for rig loads, plus is an excellent barrier against hull penetration should boat go on rocks. The gold colored Kevlar can be seen in below photo.
