

How To Get To Puerto Galera

The Simple Way

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Most of the best beach resorts in Puerto Galera, Lalaguna beaches, Sabang Beach and White Beach will provide their own transport arrangements direct from Manila (or almost anywhere else), so just ask when booking a room at your favorite beach resort. If you do not yet know where to stay in Puerto Galera, but want to find a place when you arrive, then the simple how to get to Puerto Galera way is very easy: join one of the daily scheduled bus and ferry trip arranged through the either, the Sikat Bus service or, the Swagman Hotel. Both of these bus and ferry services to Puerto Galera start their journeys in Ermita, Manila City.

Advance booking of the bus and ferry services to Puerto Galera is recommended because the services are well used, especially in the high season from November to May.

N.B. If you are arriving on an international flight at the Manila international airport NAIA (IATA code "MNL"), the Swagman Hotel offers free airport pick-up provided you stay with them for one night before departing to Puerto Galera. If you are arriving at the Clark international airport DMIA (IATA

code "CRK") then there is a frequent bus service from the Swagman Travel office in Angeles City (close to DMIA) direct to the Swagman Hotel in Ermita, Manila City.

From Puerto Galera, Muelle Pier you can get transport direct to Lalguna Beach, Sabang Beach and White Beach. Or, if you want to feed a rumbly-tummy, sate a thirst and freshen up first, simply walk along the pier to your right (the West end) and look for the Puerto Galera Yacht Club dinghy service that will take you directly to the yacht club.

What is the "EUF"? The EUF is the Environmental Usage Fee charged by municipal authorities governing tourist destination around the Philippines. The EUF may vary depending on the destination. The current EUF for non-residents entering Puerto Galera is Php50 per person. Within 2012 the EUF is expected to be raised to Php120 per person. This is a one-time fee payable before you enter the Batangas Pier Passenger Terminal building.

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
