

PGYC Easter Regatta 2025

Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro, Philippines

NOTICE OF RACE

The regatta organizing authority is the Puerto Galera Yacht Club Inc.

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1. Races will be completed using a pursuit race format. The object being that the slowest boat starts first and the fastest boat starts last. In theory all boats should finish simultaneously. The winner is the first yacht in each class to cross the finish line.
2. Racing rule(s) 26 and 61.2 will be changed as follows: no Starting Signals will be given. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. In addition, Rule 77 will not apply.
3. PY Handicap System as administered by the Sailing Committee. The list of start times will be posted prior to the event.

2. ADVERTISING

1. Advertising is permitted but boats wishing to carry their own sponsors' advertising are invited to contact the race organizers to prevent conflict with race sponsors.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

1. The regatta is open to boats of the following classes:

PY Cruiser/Racer

PY Cruiser

PY Cruising Multihulls

PY Sports Boats (including Beach Catamarans)

NB: boats with IRC certificates will compete under PY Cruiser/Racer class and will receive corrected times relevant to their IRC on presentation of IRC Certification current at the Welcome Party, 17th APRIL, 2025.



2. For a Class to be recognized by the Regatta, a minimum of 3 boats must enter the Class. Classes may be divided or combined subject to the number of entries in the Class.

4. FEES

1. The entry fee will be PhP7500 per boat, which includes 2 meal tickets for the final awards ceremony.
2. An Early Bird Discount of 10% will apply if the entry fee is paid before MARCH 31, 2025

5. SCHEDULE

1. Registration will take place online via email anytime up to April 10th, 2025, and in person at the Puerto Galera Yacht Club from 08:00hrs on FRIDAY APRIL 18TH, 2025.
2. At least one race per day. The first start each day will not be before 10:00hrs.
3. Racing will take place in the Verde Island Passage. The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions and at the daily skippers briefing each race day morning.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. The sailing instructions will be available one week prior to the first race on the PGYC website at www.pgyc.org, and will be included in the Skippers Pack.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

1. Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

8. BERTHING

1. The PGYC moorings are frequently full so competitors should have an alternate plan to anchor at Boquete Sandbar or Dalaruan Bay anchorages. Limited moorings are available on a “first paid first served” basis. Mooring fees for visiting yachts competing in the regatta will be waived for **APRIL 17-20th**. For yachts which stay on a mooring before or after the regatta the normal daily



charge will apply. Please contact the PGYC office for further details.

9. PRIZES

1. Daily prizes will be awarded to the first three places in each Class. Event Class trophies will be given to the first three places in each Class. Overall trophies will be awarded to the first three places in the event based on the low point system. If there are fewer than four entries in any class then only one competitor in that class shall be eligible for the award of an Overall trophy.
