**NOTICE OF RACE ('NOR')**  
OPTIMIST, MIRROR and OZ GOOSE CLASSES  
Organising Authority – Puerto Galera Yacht Club ('PGYC')  
(in association with the 'Philippine Sailing Association' ('PSA'))

### 1: RULES

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rules', as defined in 'The Racing Rules of Sailing' and further included in the Sailing Instructions.

### 2: COURSES

The courses will be published in the Sailing Instructions and displayed at the PGYC SBP-Clubhouse, including the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

The general racing area will be within Muelle Bay (and possibly around Medio Island, weather permitting).

### 3: CLASSES, ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to boats/crews in the following Classes:

1. OPTIMIST (Novice / Open)-under the age of 15yrs at the time of the regatta.
2. MIRROR / LAWIN (Novice / Open)- no age restrictions.
3. OZ GOOSE (Open)

For the Mirror Class the helmsperson may change between races with no penalty. Such a change is MANDATORY for the duration of any race when indicated by the committee boat flying the R flag. Failure to change helmsperson in this case will result in disqualification from that race.

### DEFINITIONS:

#### Optimist and Lawins

**NOVICE** - a) a sailor who has NOT PREVIOUSLY sailed in a regatta in that Class, *or*  
b) a sailor who has previously sailed in a regatta but did not place within the first 3 positions overall in that Class.

**OPEN** - all others. A sailor who has placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd Overall in the Optimist Open class in previous regattas is ineligible for that Class in this regatta. They may upgrade to LAWIN OPEN/NOVICE only.

**OZ GOOSE** - one class - OPEN. Single or double-handed optional.

### 4: ADVERTISING

Advertising by individuals / dinghies is permitted but individuals and/or boats wishing to carry or affix their own sponsors advertising shall prior contact PGYC, to prevent any possible conflict with any PGYC regatta or race sponsor.





## 5: FEES

There is NO entry fee

## 5: SCHEDULE

**5.1** Registration will take place at the Puerto Galera Yacht Club from 1700hrs on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October .

**5.2** At least Five (5) races in each Class each day. The first race to start each day will not be before 0800hrs (unless announced otherwise by the SBP Race Committee).

**5.3** Racing will take place inside Muelle Bay (and possibly around Medio Island, weather permitting). The courses for the Class will be described in the Sailing Instructions, and at each daily Briefing - held on each race day morning prior to racing for that day.

## 6: SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions ('SI') will be available at the latest one (1) week prior to the first race on the PGYC website at [www.pgyc.org](http://www.pgyc.org).

**7: SAFETY & ESSENTIAL EQUIPMENT:** Boat Skippers remain at all times wholly and entirely responsible for the safety of their boat and its crew. All sailors to wear PGYC approved lifejackets and follow the designated PGYC Dinghy Safety Procedures as set down in the pre-race briefing documents at all times. Safety boats will be on standby at the racing area to assist if required.

## 8: PRIZES

Overall regatta 'take home' trophies will be awarded to the first place in each Class based on the low-points system. Medals will be awarded to 2nd and 3rd places. The trophies will be awarded during the evening of the first day of the PGYC ASR2024 on Friday NOVEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> 1800hrs.

An Overall 'PGYC SBP-ASR Perennial Trophy' will be awarded to the Overall regatta winning crew (kept at the PGYC Clubhouse).

## 9: DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate entirely at their own risk (see RRS 3 Decision to Race & 4 Acceptance Of The Rules). The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

All and any Entrants must complete and sign the race Registration Form and Disclaimer of Liability and (for entrants below 18 years of age only) a Parent/Guardian Consent Form, before the first day event / racing begins.
