

## How To Get To Puerto Galera The Easy Way

Most of the best beach resorts in Puerto Galera, Lalaguna beaches, Sabang Beach and White Beach will provide their own transport arrangements direct from Manila (or almost anywhere else), so just ask when booking a room at your favorite beach resort. Check out the “Where to Stay in Puerto Galera” page on this website for some of the best beach resorts and hotels in Puerto Galera.

If you do not yet know where to stay in Puerto Galera, but want to find a place when you arrive, then the easy, zero-hassle how to get to Puerto Galera way is simple: join the daily scheduled bus & ferry service arranged through the Si-Kat Bus service ([www.sikatferrybus.com](http://www.sikatferrybus.com)). This all inclusive bus & ferry service to Puerto Galera starts its journey in Ermita, Manila City.

Advance booking of the SiKat bus & ferry services to Puerto Galera is recommended because the services are well used, especially in the high season from November to May. Service provided aboard 60 seat, air-conditioned bus includes a tour guide plus snacks & drinks available for purchase. The ferry is fully air-conditioned and its destination in Puerto Galera is Balatero Pier. Once you have arrived at Balatero Pier there are local transports and hotel & resort representatives on hand to help you choose a final destination.

What is the “EUF”? The EUF is the Environmental Usage Fee charged by municipal authorities, governing tourist destinations around the Philippines. The EUF may vary depending on the destination. The current EUF for non-residents entering Puerto Galera is Php120 per person. This is a one-time fee payable upon arrival at Balatero pier.
